All four tests give a complete jump and reactive profile. Standing vert and 10/5 RSI from the GAC girls varsity rosters 2018–2024 and Triple F testing. SL Max RSI from Triple F, per side. Approach jump is projected from standing vert, not yet measured directly.

Standing vert and approach are Just Jump mode · both RSI figures are the Legacy convention (flight time ÷ contact time)

Grade every retest in the same mode. JJ mode reads higher than flight-time mode, and Legacy RSI is a different number from Standard RSI.
